R E S O L U T I O N .

No. 41.

The Municipal Council assembled today Tuesday the 18th. of November 1914 at an extra ordinary meeting under the presidency of the Mayor Mr. John E. Lacherdis, aware of the occurred death of the Benefactor of the Schools of our Community and offering tribute of gratitude to the memory of the defunct, votes that:

- a. The peeling of bells of all Churches at the removal of the dead, and that the Cathedral's bell to continue till the burial of same.
- b. The funeral to leave at 2 p.m.
- c. The closing of all Schools for the day.
- d. The flag of the Municipality to be hoisted at half mast.
- e. The Mayor and the Municipal Council to attend the Funeral.
- f. The male and female Teaching Staff with the two upper classes of both Schools to accompany the Funeral.
- g. The Funeral Ribbon to be held by four of the Teachers, and a proper funeral speech to be made by one of the Teachers.
- h. To place a wreath on the Coffin on behalf of the Municipality.
- j. To send a letter of condolence to the Family of the Defunct on behalf of the Municipality.
- i. The present Resolution to be affixed at the Square of Constantine the Liberator.
